The Montenegro has received financing from the World Bank toward the costs of Second Institutional Development and Agriculture Strengthening Project, and intends to apply part of the proceeds for consulting services for Sectoral Studies for the Strategy for Agriculture and Rural Development 2021-2027 and the IPARD III Program 2021-2027.

The overall objective of this consulting services ("the Services") is to contribute to the preparation of the Strategy for Agriculture and Rural Development 2021-2027 and IPARD III Programme for the Ministry of Agriculture and Rural Development of Montenegro.

The assignment will - as its primary output - produce sector study reports of the meat, diary, fruits and vegetables, olive oil and wine and sector study for fisheries sector in Montenegro, as well as study for Diversification separately, in compliance with already existing sectoral studies and the report outline included in annex to this ToR. It should be stressed that both existing sectoral studies and the annex represent a general reference and that the individual sector study must reflect its own context and, if needed, include amendments to the general report outline. In addition, sectoral studies need to be supplemented with analyses of competitiveness in comparation with EU and the Region, as well as with the recognition of potential export markets in order to reduce trade imbalance.

The estimated level of efforts for the assignment is 5 expert months in a period of 6 month. The duration of work is up to 6 months, with planned starting date from July 2020, and completion date of the assignment to be December 2020.
